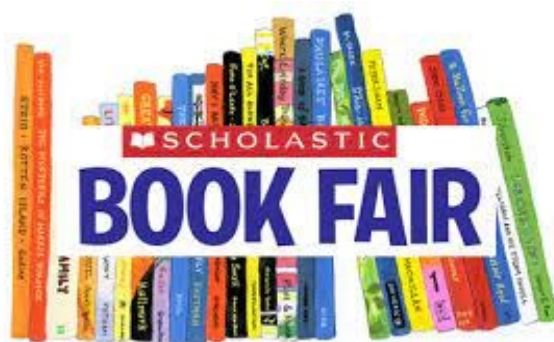

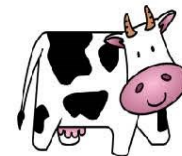

PBL Focus Lesson – being safe, respectful, and giving our best in the **COLA** area

Term 4 Week 3 2021

<p>Aim: Students develop a clear understanding of what is expected in the COLA AT PLAYING TIME.</p>		
<p>Specific skills to be taught: How do we use the COLA so we are safe, respectful and give our best always</p>		
<p>Safe What it looks like-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Morning time – if there is not a teacher – go straight to the silver seats WITH YOUR BAG and sit and wait for teacher instruction. - Right activity/ right time: No big balls under the COLA in the morning session. Of a morning during winter/cold months and wet weather, the COLA is congested. When there are too many students in one place it becomes unsafe. - Walk, Walk, Walk. 	<p>Respectful</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Include others in your game if they show interest - Play fair - Respect the equipment you use. 	<p>Our Best Always</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pack away equipment and toys after EACH BREAK for the next person to use and to make it easier for the sports monitors to pack away after lunch.
<p>Teaching Examples</p>		
<p>Example: Johnny saw Jack sitting by himself so he asked if he would like to play hand ball. Non Example: Tom pegged a ball and hit someone in the head. Example: Diane and her friends were reading quietly on the wooden bench under the COLA. Non Example: Anne and Gail were playing tips in the COLA area.</p>		
<p>Student Activity</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Discuss rules for COLA play as presented on the sign outside near the blackboard. 2. Discuss and practice play in the COLA area. 3. List some safe and unsafe situations which occur in the COLA area on a chart. 4. Identify what can happen if rules are not followed. 		
<p>Procedures for recognising appropriate behaviours:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <i>Descriptive praise e.g "I like the way you are playing under the COLA"</i> 2. <i>Refer to the PBL sign (see above) daily, before and during breaks.</i> 3. <i>Give pink Little Bells for correct behaviour.</i> 4. <i>After 'practise play', follow up in the class with a discussion.</i> 	<p>Procedures for correcting inappropriate behaviours:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Staff consistently emphasising expectations.</i> • <i>Staff consistently expecting students to follow instructions.</i> • <i>Prompt, Redirect, Reteach, Choice, Logical consequence.</i>

BUY YOUR PLACE IN HISTORY AT ATTUNGA PUBLIC SCHOOL



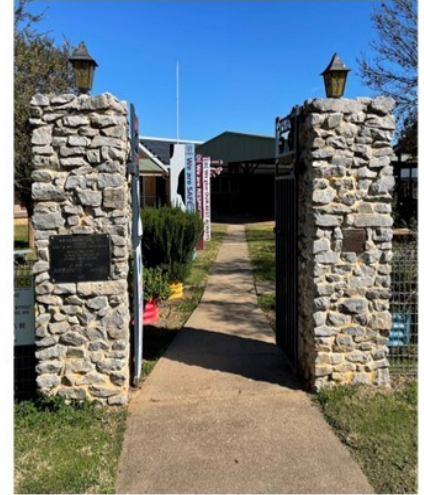
Have you been a student or staff member at Attunga Public School?

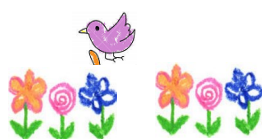
